

Districts Descriptions

00 – Ventura County except Rincon Point

05 – Carpinteria/Summerland

On the East: the Ventura County Border including Rincon Point. On the West: Start under the Sheffield Bridge and go North, then East on Ortega Ridge Rd with everything on the North in Montecito and everything on the South in Carpinteria/Summerland. Go East on East Valley Rd with everything on both sides of East Valley Rd in Montecito then past the last facing on East Valley everything in Carpinteria/Summerland. Go South on Toro Canyon with properties on both sides of Toro Canyon in Montecito and those not connected to Toro Canyon in Carpinteria/Summerland terminating at Foothill Rd.

10 – Montecito

On the East: see above. On the West: start under the Hot Springs bridge and go NW at Summit Rd to Barker Pass, including Cima Linda, Rametto and all side streets of Alston Rd. Then, going North to Sycamore Canyon terminating at Coyote Rd.

15 – SB/East of State

On the West: see above. On the West: San Marcos Pass Rd with everything on the West of San Marcos Pass in District 35 and everything on the East in District 15. On the North terminate at the National Forest line.

20 - SB/West of State

Everything on the West starting at the foot of State St and continuing to where Hollister and Modoc meet.

25 – Hope Ranch

On the East: Starting at the Hope Ranch gate. On the West: Via Cayente ending at Puente Dr. Via Tranquilla ending at Vieja Dr. including Carriage Hill Dr.

30 – SB/Goleta South

On the East: starting where Hollister and Modoc meet with everything on the South of 101 in 30 and everything on the North of 101 in 35 until just after Embarcadero.

35 – SB/Goleta North

On the East: starting at San Marcos Pass, everything on the West in 35 everything on the East in 15. Then above the National Forest line everything in 35 up to Paradise Rd. On the West: the District continues on both sides of the freeway after Embarcadero to Gaviota State Beach including Hollister Ranch.

50 – Santa Ynez

Starting after Paradise Rd. all of the Santa Ynez Valley including Solvang, Los Olivos and Buellton.

55 – Lompoc
